Day 1 - Monday, August 25th (D)

Depart for our first destination: Green Bay, Wisconsin. By late afternoon, we arrive at the **Oneida Hotel & Conference Center** in Green Bay. After checking in, unwind in your comfortable accommodations. Dinner this evening will be enjoyed at the hotel, offering relaxation and preparation for the adventures ahead.

Day 2 - Tuesday, August 26th (B,D)

After breakfast, we'll begin with an immersive experience at the **Packers Hall of Fame**. A curator will present a history lesson on the Green Bay Packers, with options for hands-on experiences or a guided Hall of Fame tour. **The Hall of Fame** is a 15,000 square foot museum where you will have the opportunity to explore firsthand the greatest story in sports. Interactives, exhibits, photo opportunities and the Lombardi Trophies are just a few of the highlights of this self-guided experience.

Following that, we'll embark on the **Heritage Trail step-on tour**, a journey through the city of Green Bay that highlights the city's rich history and its deep ties to the Packers and a stadium tour of **Lambeau Field**. Hear about iconic locations such as the press gazette building, Old City Stadium and more as this tour takes you back in time in Packers history.

Afterward, we'll head to **Green Bay's City Market** for lunch, where you'll have an opportunity to explore local dining options at your leisure. In the afternoon we'll visit **Captain's Walk Winery** for a wine tasting and tour. After this, the group will tour the nearby **Automobile Gallery** and will enjoy dinner prepared by local chefs, amidst the stunning collection of automobiles.

Day 3 - Wednesday, August 27th (B,L,D)

Come explore the history, culture, and stories of the railroad at the **National Railroad Museum**. Admission, tour, and train ride are included. This museum features a remarkable collection of locomotives, rolling stock, and artifacts, showcasing the impact of railroads on American history and culture. Hobo lunch at the National Railroad Museum is included as a part of the museum tour, dining in a setting surrounded by historic railcars and artifacts.

In the afternoon, we head to **Green Bay Botanical Garden**. Stroll through beautiful, themed garden areas and capture the natural beauty of late summer. Green Bay Botanical Garden: Explore the vibrant beauty of the Botanical Garden, featuring an array of themed landscapes and artistic plant displays. See, smell, and experience the wide variety of herbs used in culinary dishes, medicinal preparations, and overall wellness. Enjoy an herbal demonstration full of tastes, remedies, and recipes. Lastly, create your own herbal scrub to take home, fully immersing yourself in this enriching experience!

In the evening, enjoy dinner and a show at **The Backstage**, offering a lively conclusion to the day. **Let Me Be Frank** Productions has been entertaining Wisconsin for over two decades. Their all-original musicals will have you wowing at the talent, laughing in the aisle and singing a tune of yesteryear on your way home.

Day 4 - Thursday, August 28th (B,D)

After breakfast, we'll depart for Milwaukee, arriving late morning. Our first stop will be the Milwaukee Art Museum, where we'll witness the famous **Quadracci Pavilion** wings unfold to music, (weather permitting) then we'll stop at the **National Bobblehead Museum**. The National Bobblehead Hall of Fame and Museum's collection has grown gradually, currently numbering in the 10,000s. After lunch on your own, we will tour the iconic **Lakefront Brewery** made famous by the hit show **Laverne and Shirley**. After the brewery tour, we'll visit the **Pabst Mansion** for a guided tour followed by a dinner at the **Best Place**.

Day 5 - Friday, August 29th (B,D)

After breakfast, we'll embark on a guided **Iconic Milwaukee Tour**, visiting the incredible **St Josaphat's Basilica** and other landmarks such as **North Point Light House, The Bronze Fonz, Black Cat Alley**. In the afternoon, we visit the **Miller Brewery** for a tour, including lunch on your own and samples at the famous Beer Garden. Next, we'll visit the **Harley Davidson Museum**, before we gather for a farewell dinner.

Day 6 - Saturday, August 30th (B)

After breakfast, we'll begin our journey back to Michigan. Our final stop will be the **Mars Cheese Castle** in Kenosha, where you can pick up Wisconsin cheese, meats, wines, and gourmet goodies before heading home.
