Day 1
 Today, we are greeted by our professional Bianco tour guide and driver and begin our journey to our nation's capital, Washington, DC. An included lunch stop and periodic rest stops en route are made for comfort and convenience. We arrive in Arlington, Virginia where we check into the Sheraton, Pentagon City, our home for the next four nights.

Day 2
 A full breakfast buffet awaits us this morning before heading to **Ford's Theatre** where we celebrate the legacy of President Abraham Lincoln through theater and education. A working theatre, historical monument, world class museum and learning

center, Ford's Theatre is the premier destination in Washington DC to explore and celebrate Lincoln's ideals and leadership principles: courage, integrity, tolerance, equality and creative expression. Our afternoon will be spent at the National Mall, home to world renown **Smithsonian Museum Complex**. Visit the many museums and art galleries during our free afternoon. Whether you are looking for Thomas Edison's first lightbulb, Dorothy's Ruby slippers, or the Space Shuttle Discovery - there's something for everyone to explore. Dinner this evening is included at **Elephant & Castle**. At Elephant & Castle you'll find the irreplaceable charm of a quality British pub complete with traditional food, tall pints, an upbeat atmosphere and some impassioned opinions about football. This

evening we will have a **guided tour of Washington, DC's monuments and memorials**. Highlights include a drive by of the Washington Monument, and a visit to the Lincoln, Vietnam Veterans, WWII and Korean War Veterans Memorials.

Day 3

After another included breakfast, we continue to explore the history of Washington, DC. Our first stop is **Arlington National Cemetery**. Step into our nation's history and remember the American patriots, both humble and well-known, whose final resting place is in the wooded hills of Arlington. Gaze upon the tomb of the unknown soldier which is guarded 24 hours a day 365 days per year. Next, step back in time to **Mount Vernon**, the historic estate of the country's first president George Washington. Lunch will be included at Mt Vernon before you will walk the grounds and through the mansion of our first President's estate. The mansion is now home to 25 theaters and galleries, which tell the detailed story of George Washington's life with more than 500 original artifacts, 11 video presentations, and even an immersion theater experience. Many character interactions are also included throughout your visit. Our evening concludes tonight with a pizza party at a local restaurant.

Day 4

Another included breakfast awaits this morning before we depart for the **United States Capitol Building**. Still very much a working government building you can keep an eye out for your local senator as we take a guided tour through the building. You will also find historic documents, artifacts,

models, films and interactive stations that tell the story of the US Capitol and the Congress. From here we head to the beautiful town of **Annapolis, MD** on the Chesapeake Bay for lunch on your own and time to explore. Annapolis is consistently ranked one of America's most walkable towns for a good reason. This quaint, historic waterfront town has changed little since its inception in the mid-17th century. 300-year-old buildings now play host to restaurants, pubs, specialty shops, boutiques, art galleries, music venues, and so much more, all within a small area. From there we will visit the nearby **United States Naval Academy** for a guided tour. After receiving an appointment and acceptance, young men and women prepare to become professional officers of competence, character, and compassion in the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps and future leaders in our country. Dinner is included tonight in Annapolis before returning to our hotel.

Day 5

Today we will make our way home, but not without one more treat. Lunch is included at **Church Brew Works** in Pittsburgh, PA. Originally built in 1878 then restored in 1915 after a major fire, St. John served its parishioners through both world wars. After declining funds, the parish was closed in 1993. In 1996, after being restored to its former glory Church Brew Works opened. Because the altar was built as a centerpiece of the church, the steel and copper tanks gleaming in the celestial blue backdrop is nothing less than captivating. This extraordinary view is only paralleled by the quality and taste of our beer. Lunch here will be an experience on our trek home. Thank you for travelling with Bianco Tours!

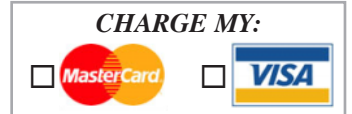
